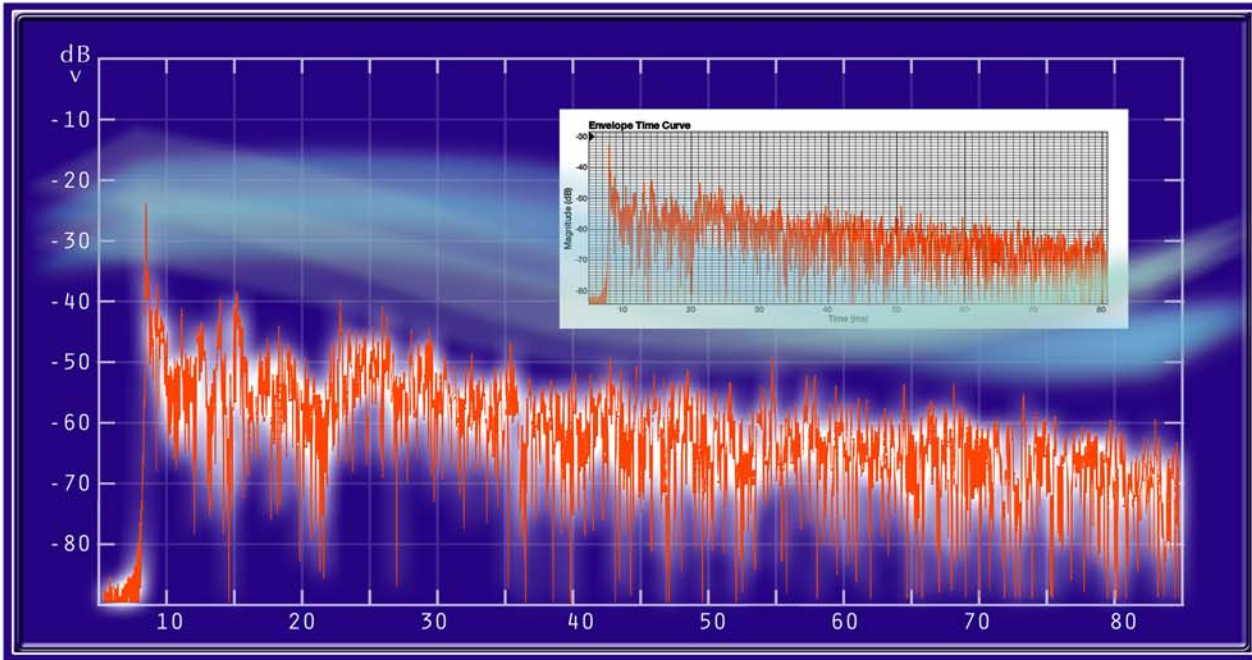

FORENSIC AUTHENTICITY ANALYSES OF AUDIO/VIDEO EVIDENCE




is important, whether you are the proponent or the opponent of audio or video evidence. Thorough Forensic Authenticity Analysis of a recording ensures, among other things, that: *i)* evidence of any type of tampering will be exposed, *ii)* any signs suggestive of falsification will be appropriately analyzed and explained, *iii)* a basis for determining whether the recording is trustworthy as a whole can be established.

Objective and thorough forensic *authenticity* examinations can at least determine:

- Whether the audio, acoustic or video evidence submitted is the true original or some copy thereof,
- Whether the recording is continuous and unaltered or not,
- Whether the recording is consistent with the operation of the original recording device(s), and
- Whether the recording is consistent with statements or testimony of the participants, witnesses and/or recordist.

FORENSIC AUTHENTICITY ANALYSES (continue)

Please note that **Professor Yonovitz** and **Attorney Joe** have been authenticating audio and video evidence for over **60** combined-years, and their authenticity procedures have overcome the only two **Daubert** challenges mounted against them.
